4 -Training content and contexts:

The content of this training program revolves around building a deep knowledge of language through learning Arabic grammar and linguistics. The program is specifically designed to achieve a very good level of language proficiency and extensive knowledge of Arabic linguistics. Mastery of the Arabic language, true ability for independent work, genuine motivation, and control are essential components for success in this field.

5. Training objectives:

This bachelor's degree is designed as a specialization in the study of the Arabic language in general and the description of spoken language in particular. Therefore, the program aims to provide learners with a linguistic culture based on a scientific perspective, which can be further developed and deepened during their university studies.

The overall objective of this specialization is to address two fundamental questions related to the basic concepts of Arabic linguistics and comprehensive linguistic diversity. As a result, students in this program can acquire advanced language skills in Arabic, including grammar, style, oral and written language, linguistics, history of language, understanding and writing documents in Arabic, editorial and oral translation, historical knowledge, culture, and thought.

6 - The targeted skills of this training program include:

- Proficiency in the Arabic language: This program aims to develop advanced language skills in both written and oral Arabic, including grammar, style, and composition.
- Research skills: Students will acquire the necessary tools for conducting scientific research related to Arabic linguistic heritage.
- Teaching skills: Graduates will have the knowledge and expertise to teach Arabic language at various educational levels, such as primary and secondary schools.
- Communication and media skills: The program prepares students for careers in journalism, media, communications, language policy, and documentation. Graduates can work as journalists, analysts, consultants, and advisors in linguistic and cultural mediation, communication consultation, and public relations.
- Cultural and publishing skills: The program also provides knowledge and skills related to culture and publishing, enabling graduates to work as editors, publishing secretaries, screenwriters, and novelists.
