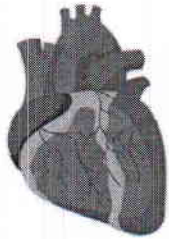

3- Complete the sentences with these words from the list: (03 pts)

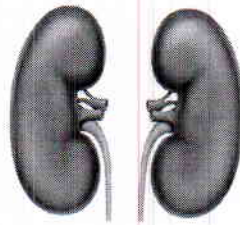
Goalkeeper - referee - defender - yellow card - give and go – attacker

1. -- **attacker** --: A player whose job is to play the ball forward towards the opponent's goal area to create a scoring opportunity.
2. -- **defender** ----: A player whose job is to stop the opposition attacking players from goal scoring.
3. -- **give and go** ----: (also known as a 1-2) When a player passes the ball to a teammate, who immediately one-touch passes the ball back to the first player.
4. -- **Goalkeeper** ----: The specialized player who is the last line of defense, who is allowed to control the ball with his hands when in the goal area.
5. -- **referee** ----: The official who is in charge of the game.
6. -- **yellow card** ----: is held up by a referee to signal a caution for a minor infringement.

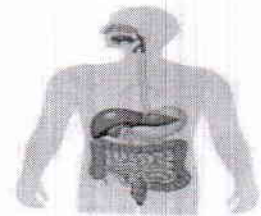
